Safe Work Practice

- Wear all basic and specialized PPE as noted above
- Do Not begin demolition without a full site inspection
- Have appropriate training
- Do Not Enter active demolition area
- Keep up with general housekeeping
- Ensure that the demolition area is fenced off when and where possible
- Use a respirator as required often demolition creates a lot of unknown dust
- Conduct a thorough hazard assessment and implement controls necessary to lower the risks
