It is recommended not to wear steel toed boots while operating a motor vehicle

- Only operate a vehicle if you are qualified to do so
- **Do Not** Operate a vehicle under the influence of drugs or alcohol
- **Do Not** Operate a vehicle without the proper safety restraints
- PPE – Glasses if visually required
- **Do Not** Leave the scene of an accident that you were involved in
- Obey all posted signs regarding speed, construction etc.
- Pull over for emergency vehicles
- Take photos of any accidents
- Always keep your eyes on the road
- **Do Not** use devices while driving
- **Do Not** drive unless you are currently a licensed driver of this province
