Potential Hazards (Risk Priority MEDIUM)

- Equipment damage
- Personal Injury and/or property damage
- Struck by
- Crushed between equipment and other objects
- Electrical Contact
- Inadequately secured load

- All personnel must ensure they have been appropriately trained by their supervisor.

Safe Work Practice

- Read the manufacturer's manual operator's manual before using the equipment
- Make sure you understand the instructions before attempting to use the machine
- Make sure the machine is in good repair before using it
- Always wear P.P.E as noted above
- An operator commencing work shall walk around the earth mover to conduct a visual inspection
- Before boarding the earth mover, the operator shall make sure no one is close to it or under it
- Safety belts shall be worn when operating the earth mover
- Ear protection shall be used when needed
- The apron shall be closed or secured from closing when working in or on the bucket
- Operators must report defective brakes or steering mechanism immediately, as well as any other
 defect which would cause unsafe operation of the machine. Defects must be reported on a
 maintenance sheet and to the supervisor.
- The tire pressure shall be checked once a week with a gauge during the construction season
- Do not get off the earth mover while it is moving
