- All personnel must ensure they have been appropriately trained by their supervisor.

- All work related injuries must be treated and reported PROMPTLY to your supervisor and or the owner and a first aid record must be completed
- All worksites will be staffed with trained first aid personnel in accordance with the WorksafeBC Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations. List of trained personnel will be posted
- First Aid supplies will be kept at every worksite, vehicle and piece of equipment in accordance with the WorksafeBC Occupational Health and Safety Act and Regulations
- All employees who are issued with a personal First Aid Kit shall ensure that the First Aid Kit is kept clean and dry and the kit's contents are replace when necessary
- First Aid Kit locations at permanent facilities shall be clearly marked
