- **Do Not** operate equipment without pre-operational inspection
- Wear the correct PPE
- Do Not use a mobile device while operating any equipment
- Do Not operate equipment that has been locked out or tagged out
- Ensure that you have received the appropriate training to operate the equipment
- Do Not speed while travelling
- Do Not use equipment for a place to sit
- Always have a spotter (where applicable)
- Always ensure that attachments are secured before operating the equipment
- Do Not operate equipment while under the influence of drugs or alcohol
